Windsor Calisthenics Club is excited to be hosting our 2021 Graceful Girl Competition at the Royalty Theatre. We would like to thank you for supporting our competition and we wish each and every competitor crossing the stage the best of luck.

### COVID-19

- Due to Covid, there are number restrictions in place at the theatre. We ask that you follow the instructions of our Covid Marshall to ensure the safety of all members in our cali community.
- Please ensure you check-in using the QR Codes or sign in sheets provided.
- While masks are not necessary if the theatre is below 50% capacity, we ask that you bring a mask along in case it is required.
- Hand sanitiser will be available in the foyer and dressing rooms.
- Dressing rooms and high touch areas will be cleaned regularly.

### COMPETITORS

- Competitors are asked to check in 30 minutes prior to their section start time.
- We ask that girls come with hair and make-up already done, if possible.
- All competitors must check in at the sign in table prior to the start of their section. They will be informed of their assigned dressing room.
- Competitors under the age of 18 must be signed in by a parent/caregiver.
- Only competitors and coaches who have signed in will be permitted in the dressing rooms. Parents will not be permitted to enter the dressing room.
- Dressing rooms will open 45 minutes prior to Competition Start on each day.
  - 5:15pm – Thursday and Friday
  - 8:15am – Saturday and Sunday
- Please note all session times are an approximate guide only, however we will aim to keep to the listed times. Any updates will be posted on our Facebook page.
- Competitors must exit the dressing room with all their belongings at the end of their adjudication.
- All participants must wear shoes when walking around the theatre.
- If space allows, competitors may watch in the auditorium until it is time for their adjudication.

### COACHES

- As 2021 Coaches Cards are not available yet, please purchase a ticket via Trybookings. Tickets are free.
- You will be given a wrist band to allow you access to the dressing room, and theatre if space allows.
- Level 1 coaches are available to put competitors on stage, if required.

### MUSIC and LIGHTING

- Music
  - Music/DLP will need to be on USB.
  - One competitor per USB please.
  - This will need to be handed in at the check in desk.
- Lighting
  - Full stage lighting is available as per CASA Rules.
  - If you are calling live lights, please provide a lighting sheet at check-in.

## VIDEO and PHOTOGRAPHY

- Due to Child Protection Laws, no personal video or photography of participants on stage is permitted. Non-compliance may result in removal from the theatre auditorium.
- Event Clips will be recording the competition and performances will be available for purchase from the foyer.
- Kellie's Pix will be available for stage photos.

## TICKETS

- All tickets will be available to purchase online only.

- Tickets will be available for purchase throughout the duration of the competition.
- Due to number restrictions, all attendees must have a ticket.
- Tickets will need to be printed or available on mobile phones to enable the QR Code on the ticket to be scanned.

## THEATRE

- We ask that audience members:
  - Only sit downstairs. There will be no upstairs seating.
  - Remain in seats while competitors are performing on stage.
  - Ensure mobile phones are turned off or are on silent.
  - Remove any rubbish when leaving the auditorium.
  - Observe Covid safe practices and avoid loitering in the foyer.
  - Exit of the auditorium after each adjudication via Moore Street.
  - Spectators who are seeing back-to-back sessions will be required to leave and re-enter with the appropriate ticket.

## CANTEEN

- Food and drinks will be available to purchase in the foyer throughout the event.
- To reduce cash handling, EFTPOS is our preferred method of payment.
- No hot food or drinks (except water) is permitted in the auditorium.
